OPEN CALL SUBMISSION GUIDELINES Michael Landy: *DEMONSTRATION*

An exhibition that evolves
over the course of six months with your engagement



The Power Plant and Michael Landy invite you to participate in his upcoming exhibition at the gallery, beginning Fall 2017.

From 29 September 2017 until 13 May 2018, acclaimed artist Michael Landy will transform the walls of The Power Plant's Fleck Clerestory into a continually evolving exhibition, *DEMONSTRATION*, built with the participation of the public. [Read more about the exhibition here.](#)

Submissions of graphic material can be images, texts, slogans, words or symbols of what makes you happy or sad, what you feel strongly about, want to react against, protest, or support and champion; issues that capture Canada's social and political reality, and affect our contemporary landscape in 2017. Michael Landy will then select images from the submissions to develop as part of the continually growing installation.

Submission Dates:

While submissions will be accepted throughout the duration of the exhibition, materials received by **10 September 2017** will be considered for inclusion in our official opening reception on 28 September 2017.

Submission Guidelines:

1. Please submit digital material to submissions@thepowerplant.org OR using the hashtag **#TPPDemonstration** on social media.
2. If you are submitting images, each submission can include 1-3 images at a **maximum size of 2.5 MB** each in **jpeg, jpg** and **png** file format.

3. You will receive an email confirmation of your graphic image submission.
4. The artist will transform selected materials from all submissions into protest drawings for *DEMONSTRATION*.
5. Individuals who submitted any selected material will be notified of selection via email. If your image has been converted into a drawing, you will receive an email and you can collect the drawing after the end of the exhibition.
6. From 5 PM to 8 PM every Thursday evening, the option to deposit printed images at The Power Plant will be offered to those who are not able to submit electronically.
